PURPOSE The Pearls of the Ivy (PIF) Scholarship Fund was established in 2008. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to exemplary high school students who are accepted by an accredited college or university. The PIF Scholarship principally targets students graduating from a high school within the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Duncanville, Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie, Texas.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and community involvement including but not limited to volunteer hours.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The PIF awards scholarships utilizing a comprehensive rubric based process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, and Personal Essay. The foundation will remit scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have verifiable proof of permanent residence status in the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, Desoto, Duncanville or Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie or attend High School in one of the aforementioned independent school districts.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college or university for the upcoming 2018 –
 2019 academic year. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant. Proof of enrollment will be required from the recipient.
- Preference may be given to applicants who have participated in PIF or Alpha Kappa alpha Sorority, Inc.
 Upsilon Lambda Omega Chapter programs.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Friday, March 16, 2018.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due by Friday, March 16, 2018.
- Applicants will be notified if awarded a scholarship by April or May 2018.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- Three recommendations as follows:
 - > Two academic recommendations from a guidance counselor and/or teacher(s).
 - ➤ One recommendation from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
