**PURPOSE** The Pearls of the Ivy Foundation (PIF)/Angela L. Davis Henry Educational Enrichment Scholarship Fund was established in 2013. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to exemplary high school students who have shown high academic achievement and who are accepted by an accredited college or university. The PIF Scholarship principally targets students graduating from a high school within the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Duncanville, and Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie Texas.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and community involvement including but not limited to volunteer hours.

## **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

The PIF awards scholarships utilizing a comprehensive rubric based process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References and Personal Essay. The foundation will remit scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

### **CRITERIA**

- African American graduating high school senior.
- Applicants must have verifiable proof of permanent residence status in the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, Desoto, Duncanville or Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie, Texas or attend High School in one of the aforementioned independent school districts.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college or university for the upcoming 2021 –
   2022 academic year. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant. Proof of enrollment will be required from the recipient.

- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Thursday, April 1, 2021.

#### TIMELINE

- Applications are due by Thursday, April 1, 2021.
- Applicants will be notified if awarded a scholarship by May 2021.

- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- Scanned application (pages 1-5) and all supporting documents into one PDF document.

  - Multiple attachments will not be accepted, and application will be deemed incomplete.
