PURPOSE The Pearls of the Ivy Foundation (PIF) Scholarship Fund was established in 2008. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to exemplary high school students who are accepted by an accredited college or university. The PIF Scholarship principally targets students graduating from a high school within the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Duncanville, Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie, Texas.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and community involvement including but not limited to volunteer hours.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The PIF awards scholarships utilizing a comprehensive rubric based process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, and Personal Essay. The foundation will remit scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- African American graduating senior attending the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, Desoto,
 Duncanville or Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie or attend High School in one of the aforementioned independent school districts.
- Applicants must have verifiable proof of permanent residence status in the Best Southwest Cities of Cedar Hill, Desoto, Duncanville or Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, and Waxahachie or attend High School in one of the aforementioned independent school districts.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college or university for the upcoming 2021 –
 2022 academic year. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant. Proof of enrollment will be required from the recipient.
- Preference may be given to applicants who have participated in PIF or Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. Upsilon Lambda Omega Chapter programs.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Thursday, April 1, 2021.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due by **Thursday**, **April 1**, **2021**.
- Applicants will be notified if awarded a scholarship by May 2021.

- Three one-page recommendation letters verifying activities and involvement as follows:
- One academic recommendation from a guidance counselor.
- One academic recommendation from a teacher or principal.
- One recommendation from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational, or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- Scanned application (pages 1-5) and all supporting documents into one PDF document.
 - School Official's Signature on Page 4 of application can be electronic or physical signature.
 - Multiple attachments will not be accepted, and application will be deemed incomplete.
