**PURPOSE** The Pearls of the Ivy Foundation (PIF)/Jenine D. Robinson McClaney, MBA Excellence in Leadership Scholarship was established in 2015. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to exemplary female high school students who are attending Tennessee State University as an undergraduate student.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based academic performance, leadership potential, and community involvement including but not limited to volunteer hours.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

The PIF awards scholarships utilizing a comprehensive rubric based process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, and Personal Essay. The foundation will remit scholarship funds directly to Tennessee State University. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

#### **CRITERIA**

- African American graduating senior attending high school in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.
- Applicants must have verifiable proof of permanent residence status in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at Tennessee State University-Nashville, Tennessee
  for the upcoming 2021 2022 academic year. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program
  that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant. Proof of enrollment will be required from the
  recipient.
- Preference may be given to applicants who have participated in PIF or Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority,
   Inc. Upsilon Lambda Omega Chapter programs and those who live in the Best Southwest Cities of

Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Duncanville, Lancaster, Glenn Heights, Red Oak, Oak Leaf, Ovilla, Midlothian, or Waxahachie, Texas.

- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Thursday, May 13, 2021.

#### **TIMELINE**

- Applications are due by Thursday, May 13, 2021.
- Applicants will be notified if awarded a scholarship by May 2021.

- Completed application form.
- High school transcript or current University transcript.
- One-page list of community service and school activities.
- Three recommendation letters as follows:
  - > One academic recommendation from a guidance counselor.
  - > One academic recommendation from a teacher or principal.
  - One recommendation from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance into Tennessee State University.
- Scanned application (pages 1-5) and all supporting documents into one document.
  - Multiple attachments will not be accepted, and application will be deemed incomplete.
